

Evaluation of Whether A Site-wide Environmental Impact Statement Would Facilitate Future NEPA Compliance Efforts

A supplement analysis (SA) was prepared to evaluate the *Final Environmental Impact Statement for the Continued Operation of the Pantex Plant and Associated Storage of Nuclear Weapon Components (SWEIS)*. This SA met the Department of Energy (DOE) regulations that require that Site-Wide EISs be evaluated at least every 5 years after issuance to determine whether a supplemental or new EIS is necessary (10 CFR 1021.330[d]). *DOE/EIS-0225/SA-03* was finalized in February of 2003. The determination was made that the current Site-Wide EIS, *DOE/EIS-0225*, adequately represents and analyzes impacts from the continued operation of the Pantex Plant and, therefore, no further NEPA documentation is required.
