
SUBJECT: 2004 Annual National Environmental Policy Act

Southwestern Power Administration (Southwestern) is submitting this Annual National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) planning summary as required by DOE Order 451.1B, and (National Environmental Policy Act Compliance Program, Section 5.a (7)).

As required by DOE Order 451.1B, Section 4.d the following information is submitted.

1. Status of Ongoing NEPA Compliance Activities: Southwestern remains in compliance with its NEPA responsibilities.
2. Environmental Assessment Expected to be Prepared in the Next 12 Months: Southwestern does not anticipate the preparation of any environmental assessments during the next 12 months.
3. Environmental Impact Statement to be Prepared in the Next 24 Months: Southwestern does not expect to prepare any environmental impact statements during the next 24 months.
4. Planned Cost and Schedule for Completion of Each NEPA Review Identified: Southwestern has not identified any costs or schedules for completion of NEPA reviews (e.g. environmental assessment and environmental impact statements).
