
SUBJECT: **ANNUAL NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT PLANNING  
SUMMARY FOR 2004 - OAK RIDGE OPERATIONS OFFICE**

TO: Beverly A. Cook, Assistant Secretary for Environment, Safety and Health, EH-1, FORS

This correspondence transmits the Annual National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Planning Summary for 2004 for the Oak Ridge Operations Office (ORO). This is in accordance with the June 1994 Secretarial Policy Statement on NEPA and Department of Energy Order 451.1B. The attached summary provides a brief description of the status of ongoing NEPA compliance activities and planned Environmental Assessments (EA) expected to be required in the next 12 months and Environmental Impact Statements expected to be required in the next 24 months. The summary will be made available for public review at public reading rooms in Oak Ridge, Tennessee, and Newport News, Virginia.

Currently there are no plans for a site wide document for the Oak Ridge Reservation; however, an EA was completed at ORNL in 2001 for the ORNL Facilities Revitalization Project which covered many of the activities at the site. The East Tennessee Technology Park activities include mainly Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) actions relating to site closure and reindustrialization efforts that are covered by existing EAs.

This summary covers all of the ORO sites. NEPA responsibilities for Paducah, Kentucky, and Portsmouth, Ohio, have been recently transferred to the new Portsmouth/Paducah Project Office and only those NEPA actions that were reported in the ORO NEPA Planning Summary for 2003 have been included in the ORO summary. Proposed actions for 2004 should be reported by the new Portsmouth/Paducah Project Office.
