The Y-12 SWEIS assesses the potential environmental impacts associated with the continued operation of the Y-12 National Security Complex, and the proposed construction and operation of the HEU Storage Mission and Special Materials Mission at Y-12 in support of assigned nuclear weapons stockpile management requirements at Y-12. There is no plan or proposal in the Y-12 SWEIS to build a new bomb plant or to manufacture new nuclear weapons. The issue of whether DOE should produce nuclear weapons and alternative uses of the Nation's funds are beyond the scope of the Y-12 SWEIS.
