PREFACE

This Directory provides information on potential stakeholders for the Department of Energy's actions under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA). The Directory was prepared by the Office of NEPA Policy and Assistance, in consultation with the Office of Congressional, Public, and Intergovernmental Affairs. The Directory is also available on the Department's NEPA Web at <http://tis.eh.doe.gov/nepa/>.

Among the public involvement provisions of the Council on Environmental Quality regulations implementing NEPA are the following requirements, which are binding on the Department:

- Agencies must ensure that environmental information is available to public officials and citizens before decisions are made and before actions are taken [40 CFR 1500.1(b)].
- Agencies must involve environmental agencies, applicants, and the public, to the extent practicable, in preparing environmental assessments and must affirmatively solicit comments on draft environmental impact statements from those persons or organizations who may be interested or affected [40 CFR 1501.4(b) and 1503.1(a)(4)].
- Agencies must also provide public notice of NEPA -related hearings, public meetings, and the availability of environmental documents so as to inform those persons and agencies who may be interested or affected and must solicit appropriate information from the public [40 CFR 1506.6(b) and (d)].

To assist Department program and field offices in compliance with these requirements, this Directory includes the following potential stakeholders:

- Federal Agencies
- State NEPA Points of Contact
- Departmental Points of Contact for Indian Tribal Issues
- Non-Governmental Organizations

Note: Departmental offices should exercise judgment in determining which of the listed stakeholders actually are interested in a particular proposed action. Listing in this Directory is not meant to imply that the person or organization listed should receive every Departmental NEPA document.

For practical reasons, the Directory does not include comprehensive information on local governments or organizations. Rather, the information provided is meant to supplement any lists of affected or interested parties that Departmental offices may have compiled for particular projects or facilities.
