

Foreword

This document provides the framework for implementing Enhanced Work Planning (EWP) projects and applying the lessons learned from previous EWP demonstrations. Activities essential to the success of the effort, roles and responsibilities of participants, and communication plans are described. In addition tools such as samples of implementation plans, time line, briefing manual, and presentation overheads are provided.

The general approaches described in this document have proven successful at the initial EWP demonstrations carried out across the DOE complex (Lessons learned from EWP projects at Hanford, Idaho, Oak Ridge and Fernald are included).
